Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club	• Access to Facilities: Reciprocal Club Members should obtain a visiting membership before they may use the Club's facilities. They may register with the Membership Office through email prior to their arrival or at our Reception when they arrive the club for the first time. A letter of introduction, a copy of their inbound and outbound flight schedule are required when register. Our Club is a cash-free club. Visitors' expenses can be settled through a pre-signed credit card authorisation, or by an Octopus Card (a stored-value card) which is a commonly used in Hong Kong for public transportation and purchase at most of the sales outlets.
